Please read this document carefully. Information in this document changes from one vacation care to the other.
If you have any questions please see Rachael.

Enrolment Forms are attached – please have forms returned to the centre ASAP, as we fill up fast.
Forms submitted after **Wednesday 14th December** date will incur a \$20.00 'late processing fee'.

Enrolment Procedure

- . 1st Priority will be given to children attending before and after school care at any of our 3 services, forms are available 3 weeks prior to each vacation care period, starting Monday 28th November, and must be returned by the Friday the 2nd December to receive priority enrolment. After this we open enrolment to the general public. **Priority enrolments will only be accepted if Before & After School Care fees are paid up to date.** After the 2nd December, we will open enrolment to the general public.
- . Each child must have a separate enrolment form.
- . Enrolment forms need to be fully completed before they will be accepted, so please read all forms carefully before lodging.
- . Enrolments are only confirmed when you receive a statement via e-mail or post. Please read your statement to ensure you are booked in correctly. All booked days and excursions must be paid for by the due date, to secure your place.
- . Vacation care enrolment forms and other information can be found on our website www.activitycentres.com.au

Fees

- . Up until the 31st of December 2011, full fees are \$38.00 per child per day (fees vary depending on your CCB) with a \$10.00 per family booking fee. As of the 1st January 2012, Vacation care fees are \$40.00 per child per day (fees vary depending on your CCB). The booking fee remains unchanged.
- . **Vacation Care Fees for December must be paid in full by Wednesday 14th December 2011.**
- . **Vacation Care Fees for January must be paid in full by Wednesday 4th January 2012.**
- . Booked days must be paid for even if your child is absent. Cancellations will only be considered if your place can be filled.
- . If your child is absent on any day of the holidays you need to call and inform the centre in the morning of your child's absence or you will be charged a \$10.00 non-notification fee.
- . If your before and after school care fees are not paid up to date you will not receive a place for holiday care.

Excursions

- . Parents/guardians need to sign the permission note on the enrolment form for your child to be able to attend excursions. It is the Parent/guardians responsibility to read the 'What's on in Vacation Care' document to ensure you are aware of all the details in regard to the individual excursions.
- . Children will travel to and from each venue in a chartered bus; the bus will be driven and insured by the hire company.
- . All excursions have limited places available due to limited seating on the bus, a waiting list will operate if needed.
- . It is parents/guardians responsibility to ensure that children arrive at the centre on time for the excursion. We will not wait and hold up the excursion for late children. All departure/arrival times are outlined in the 'What's on in vacation care' section (pg 4) of this handout and are also displayed around the centre throughout the holidays.
- . Permission note must be signed & money for excursions paid by Wednesday 4th January 2012.
- . We have a 1 adult to 8 children ratio on all excursions. All excursions have a minimum of 7 staff (we have a maximum excursion capacity of 55 children). Additional staff will attend if needed (special needs funding for children with additional needs).
- . **No refund** can be provided to families whose children do not attend excursions where the venue requires prepayment, venues that require pre-payment will be indicated on the 'What's on in vacation care' section of this form.
- . It is important to send enough food to last the day in a small backpack (**do not send a plastic bag**).
- . Children **must** have a refillable drink bottle on excursion days, so it can be refilled with water if needed. If your child does not have a refillable drink bottle we will provide them with one at an additional charge of \$2.00, which will be added to your account.
- . **We do not allow spending money**; enough food and drinks must be sent from home. Children will not be permitted to buy anything from any gift shops or canteens when on any excursion with the service. This is due to safety and supervision reasons. Please do not provide your child/ren with any money.
- . Parents are welcome to attend excursions, if there is enough room on the bus, please see Rachael if you are interested.
- . All children must wear the centre's polo shirt on all excursions, which displays the centre's name & phone number; shirts can be purchased for \$15.00 or may be borrowed and returned to staff after excursion so it can be washed and ready for the next adventure.
- . Parents **should** pack an extra set of clothes, just in case your child needs them whilst we are out.

Incursions

- These are where groups or individuals come into the service and do a performance, workshop or various activities with the children.
- Incursions are compulsory for all children attending the service and come at an additional cost which is indicated on the 'What's on' section of this handout, and will be deducted from your account when your form is being processed.
- The 'What's on' handout also outlines performance/workshop times, so that your child does not miss out. It is a parent/guardians responsibility to ensure your child is on time for the incursion.

Leave school grounds

- Sometimes during the holidays we take the children out of the school grounds either to go for a walk to the park or Toongabbie shops, to watch the daily stage show, with the centre staff during this vacation care period.
- Staff to child Ratios are maintained on these trips.
- Permission to leave school grounds needs to be signed, on the enrolment form, for children to be able to leave the grounds with the staff.

Bikes and Scooters

- Bikes and scooters have been programmed on a specific day so we can provide a safe environment for children to ride in.
- Please talk with your child about the rules outlined below, any child not following these rules will not be permitted to ride during the holidays.

BIKE AND SCOOTER RULES – Please discuss with your children

1. All children must follow directions of the staff at all times.
2. All children must have a helmet and closed in shoes (no thongs) to be able to ride at the service. If children do not have a helmet or required shoes staff will not allow them to ride.
3. Children will not be allowed to ride another child's bike or scooter. Only the owner will be permitted to ride.
4. Children will only be permitted to ride bikes and scooters on specified days (outlined in the 'what's on' page attached).
5. Children will not be able to do bike and scooter 'tricks'.
6. Bikes and scooters need to be walked into and out of the school grounds so that children playing do not get run over.
7. All Bikes and Scooters must be collected by parents at the end of the day, we do not have room to store bike and scooter equipment.
8. Bikes and Scooters need to be in a well maintained order and safe for children to ride.
9. Children need to ride within the designated riding area.

Electronic Games

- Children can bring along their electronic games to be played with during the allocated times only.
- Please read and discuss the electronic games rules and conditions with your children before they attend vacation care. They can be found below. If children bring electronic games to the service they will be bound by these rules.
- To comply with child protection policy, children who have a new DSi console (or any other console that has a working camera) must ensure that the camera lens is covered and it must remain covered whilst at the centre or the game console will be confiscated and your child will not be able to bring it to the centre.

Electronic Games Rules – Please discuss with your children

1. All Electronic Games must be charged at home, we do not charge electronic games at the centre.
2. Children are only allowed to bring in 1 game each day (to avoid them being lost).
3. All Electronic Games must have Child's name clearly written in permanent ink, and can be given to staff for safe keeping. Children will need to sign their electronic games in and out of staff care.
4. All Staff agree that it is the children's holiday time and they should be able to choose what activities they would like to participate in, however if allowed, some children will sit and play Electronic Games all day. To ensure your child has access to a wide range of daily activities we have introduced "Electronic Game Times" Children are only allowed to play Electronic Games Before 8.30 / Between 10.45 and 11.45 / Between 2.30 & 3.30 or after 5.00 (we maintain the right to change the times depending on what activities are available on particular days).
5. Children are responsible for taking care of their own Electronic Games and the centre and its staff can not be held liable for Electronic Games if it is broken, lost or stolen. Children are only allowed to bring in games rated **G** or **PG**.
6. If children do not abide by these rules the staff will confiscate Electronic Games until the end of the day.
7. Children are not to take Electronic Games on excursions.

Food

- For the safety and protection of our anaphylaxis children, **do not send any products containing nuts, including Nutella**
- Children often eat more during vacation care as they are running around and have access to their bags all day, please send along enough nutritious food to last the day, extra sandwiches & fruit will fill them up and give them the energy they need for the day.
- DO NOT SEND anything that needs to be cooked or prepared, you must send a packed lunch, like you would send to school.
- Breakfast is available until 8.30 sharp.
- Afternoon tea - Children will have access to a fresh fruit and vegetable platter to complement the snack they bring in from home.

Behaviour

- All children are expected to follow the centre rules and staff instructions.
- The centre will not tolerate children who continually use offensive language.

- . The centre will not tolerate children who are bullies and make the other children feel threatened or uncomfortable.
- . If your child continues to be disruptive their place at the centre may be terminated.
- . Children who are unable to follow staff instructions or who are disrespectful to staff may have their place terminated.
- . Parents are expected to set a good example to their children by treating the staff with respect. Complaints and Grievances should be dealt with in an appropriate manner. Please refer to our Complaints and Grievances policy located at the centre or on our website www.activitycentres.com.au

Health and Safety

- . Fire drills are practiced at the start of the holiday period, and then randomly throughout. With the evacuation plan in place and located on the front door of the centre.
- . First aid box is in easy reach and well stocked at all times.
- . At all times we will have staff on the grounds and on excursions who hold a current first aid certificate.
- . Parents will be contacted if their child becomes ill, injured or very upset.
- . Parents will be informed if there are any infectious diseases in circulation.

Dress

- . We often do a lot of messy activities and would prefer children wear old play clothes, (not brand new designer labels). Children cannot enjoy themselves if they are worried about getting their clothes dirty. Children need to dress according to the weather conditions.

Be safe and sun smart

For the safety and protection of all children they must wear;

- . A shirt that covers their shoulders, **DO NOT SEND CHILDREN IN SINGLET TOPS.**
- . A hat that covers their face and neck. (**no visors**).
- . Children must apply sun cream before they leave home, it is then available at the centre for children to self apply throughout the day.
- . **ALL CHILDREN ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR SENSIBLE FOOTWEAR,** no thongs or slip on shoes allowed.

Lost property

- . Label all removable clothing (hats, clothing and shoes) so they can be returned to their rightful owner.
- . Please check the lost property daily; unclaimed lost property will be given to a local charity at the end of the holidays.

Mobile Phones

- . Children are not to bring mobile phones to the centre. If your child is caught with a mobile phone it will be taken off them and locked away until a parent collects them.

General Information

- . All children MUST be signed into care each morning and out in the afternoon. The centre cannot be held responsible for any child not signed into care; Children not signed into care by a parent/guardian will be marked absent.
- . Ice blocks 60c, & JJ snacks 1.00c, are available at afternoon tea 3.30pm. Proceeds go towards sponsoring our World Vision Children.
