Nerf gun play	Injury to eyes/face	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All children will be spoken to as a group prior to activity about safe play rules and where they can and cannot aim.</li> <li>- Strictly no aiming at face or head.</li> <li>- Protective eyewear to be offered where available.</li> <li>- Educators use close supervision to ensure children are following rules and intervene immediately if unsafe behaviour occurs.</li> <li>- Any child not abiding by rules will sit out of the activity.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	Prior to and during activity
	Bumps, cuts, grazes or collisions from running	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Educators to explain designated play boundaries and safe movement expectations before activity commences.</li> <li>- Indoor areas to remain out of bounds unless specified safe zones.</li> <li>- Children reminded to walk in indoor areas and remain aware of surroundings.</li> <li>- Outdoor checklist completed prior to activity to ensure grounds are safe and free from hazards.</li> <li>- Appropriate footwear required at all times.</li> <li>- First aid kit fully stocked and accessible.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	Prior to and during activity
	Slips, trips and falls due to darts/equipment on ground	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Educators conduct regular checks and encourage children to collect darts throughout activity.</li> <li>- Clear play spaces maintained free from obstacles and clutter.</li> <li>- Play area boundaries clearly identified.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	During activity
	Children getting sunburned or heat-related illness	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Educators will not allow participation unless sunscreen has been applied and hats are worn during outdoor play (pending UV)</li> <li>- RP to check UV levels during morning safety checklist and determine safe outdoor times.</li> <li>- Water available at all times and regular drink breaks encouraged.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	Prior to and during activity



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			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Activity modified or ceased during extreme heat/weather conditions.</li> </ul>		
	Unsafe use of Nerf guns/equipment	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Equipment checked prior to use for damage or faults.</li> <li>- Only age-appropriate Nerf equipment used.</li> <li>- Children instructed on correct and safe handling of equipment.</li> <li>- No physical contact permitted during play.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	Prior to and during activity
	Emotional distress, rough play or conflict between children	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Educators model respectful behaviour and reinforce fair play expectations.</li> <li>- Children supported with conflict resolution strategies where required.</li> <li>- Alternative quiet activities available if children no longer wish to participate.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	During activity
	Spread of germs through shared equipment	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Children encouraged to sanitise hands before and after activity.</li> <li>- Nerf guns and shared equipment cleaned and disinfected regularly in line with health and hygiene procedures.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	Before and after activity
	Asthma or medical incidents during active play	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Medical management plans reviewed prior to activity.</li> <li>- Medication easily accessible.</li> <li>- Staff with current first aid, CPR, asthma and anaphylaxis training available during activity.</li> <li>- Children monitored for signs of distress or overexertion.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	Prior to and during activity
	Emergency or injury requiring first aid	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Fully stocked first aid kit accessible at all times.</li> <li>- Educators trained in first aid respond immediately.</li> <li>- Incidents documented according to service policy and families informed where required.</li> </ul>	RP/Educators	During activity
