

## Pets Control Policy

## Policy Statement

• We aim to provide a clean and safe environment by ensuring that every effort is made to maintain a vermin free environment. We will endeavour to do this with the minimum use of chemicals.

## **Procedures**

	Equipment will be stored in a manner to limit exposure to any pests or vermin.  Food items will be stored in containers so as not to attract vermin and pests. – refer to Activity Centres inc, Food Handling and Storage policy.
	Refuse bins will be emptied and cleaned daily.
	The service will be checked daily for signs of pests or vermin.
	Should any pests or vermin be identified then action shall be taken to rid the service of the problem by:  Initially using non-chemical methods such as physical removal, maintaining a clean environment, and use or
	<ul> <li>any non-chemical products.</li> <li>Low irritant, environmentally friendly sprays will be used minimally and only with adequate ventilation and not ir the presence of the children.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Other methods such as the employment of a pest control company if deemed necessary by the management committee where the above methods have failed.</li> </ul>
	If urgent the coordinator or manager will contact the school or parish should also be informed of the issues and will work together to hire a contractor to address the problem.
	If non-urgent the manager will bring the problem to the attention of the committee and the committee will decide on the appropriate course of action.
	Any use of chemicals shall only be conducted outside the hours of the children's and educators presence in the building.
Cl	hecklist for Staff
	Staff must keep all areas clean and tidy free of food scraps and crumbs to avoid attracting vermin.
	Low irritant, environmentally friendly sprays can be used if needed once the children have gone to school /home. Staff should dispose of any dead vermin and clean and sanitise the area.
V	Infestations need to be reported to management so professional pest control can take place.
