Control Measures

- Lost/absconding children
- Staff to ensure that they are leading the children safely looking out for any potential dangers
- Staff to wear high visibility safety jacket at all times
- Children to be supervised at all times and when going to toilet or drink breaks staff to accompany children at all times
- Roll to be taken and headcounts to be completed; if child cannot be located, the 'missing child' procedure will be enacted
- Children who may be deemed to abscond will be closely supervised at all times
- Children will be spoken to before leaving for Adventure play about appropriate behaviour and remaining with educators at all times
- A minimum of two staff members to attend so that if a child does abscond, one educator can run after them if needed
- Mobile phone to be taken and/ or walkie talkies is there is an educator back at the oosh building
- * Trips/falls/bruises/sprains on the walk to and from playground
- blayground
- Spider/ insect bites and/or allergic reactions

- At least one staff member in attendance must hold a current first aid certificate
- First aid kit must be taken every trip
- Staff to ensure they are leading the children via a safe route and on the look out for any potential tripping hazards
- One staff member to walk at the front of the children and one at the back of the group
- Staff to do a check around playground prior to children playing
- Ensure that staff are supervising children and directing them to keep their hands out of holes and small spaces
- Staff to be trained in first aid / dealing with Spider bites
- First aid kit and mobile phone to be taken
